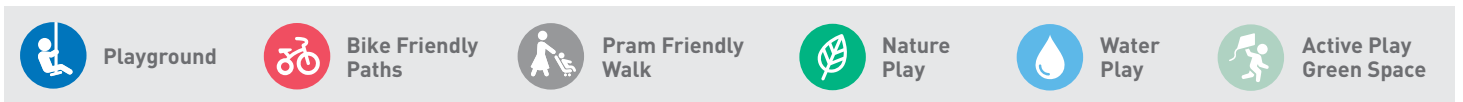
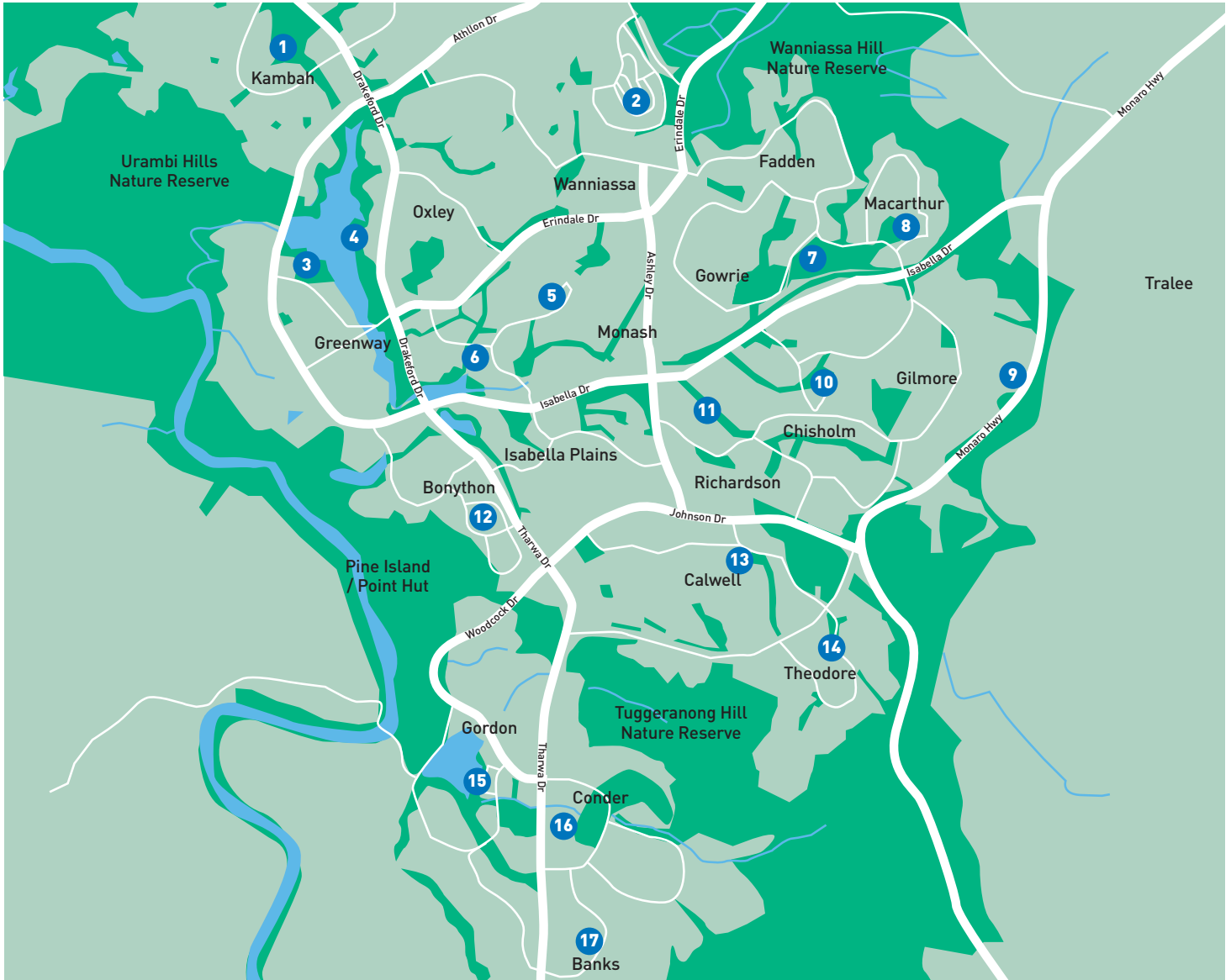


MY WAY TO PLAY - TUGGERANONG REGION
